MILESTONES & ACHIEVEMENTS

As we step into a new year, we reflect with gratitude and pride on all we have achieved together. Here's a glimpse into some of the key milestones from the past three years:



LOVE OUTREACH 1.0

IBADAN AND ABEOKUTA (DECEMBER 2021)

We extended love and support to children and orphans at the Juvenile Facility in Sango, Ibadan, as well as the Boys Juvenile Correctional Facility in Abeokuta. Our outreach included the delivery of raw food items and thoughtful gifts, positively impacting a total of 215 individuals.



LOVE CONFERENCE 1.0

ABEOKUTA (AUGUST 2022)

We empowered young secondary school students with transformative life lessons, WAEC and JAMB scholarships, and essential educational materials, including books, mathematical sets, and more. This initiative reached and positively impacted 71 children and teenagers.



LOVE OUTREACH 2.0

LAGOS (DECEMBER 2022)

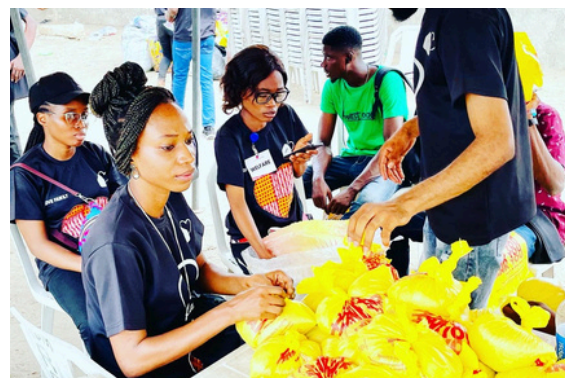
We visited the Girls Correctional Centre at Idi-Araba to connect with the girls and remind them of how cherished they are. During our time there, we provided essential supplies, including sanitary pads and raw food items, reaching a total of 105 girls.



GHETTO OUTREACH 1.0

LAGOS (APRIL 2023)

We brought love and hope to the slums of Ijora-Badia, Lagos, sharing the message of Jesus and extending practical support. Our outreach included distributing clothes, shoes, and food items, conducting a medical outreach for the elderly, and engaging children in meaningful and productive activities. Altogether, we positively impacted 180 individuals.



LOVE CONFERENCE 2.0

OGBOMOSO (AUGUST 2023)

Equipped young secondary school students in Ogbomoso with essential life skills, including tech training, shared moments of prayer with them, and provided educational materials, positively impacting 12 students.



LOVE OUTREACH 3.0

ILORIN (DECEMBER 2023)

We visited the Juvenile Correctional Home at Oko-Erin, Ilorin, Kwara State, to inspire and uplift the children. We shared words of encouragement, prayed with them, and, most importantly, emphasized the greatness they can achieve regardless of their current circumstances. This impactful outreach touched the lives of 13 children.



GHETTO OUTREACH 2.0

MAKOKO (MARCH 2024)

We visited over 120 children and adults in the Makoko slum of Lagos, offering healthcare services and equipping the younger generation with valuable skills through targeted training, fostering empowerment and hope within the community.



OKADA OUTREACH 1.0

IBADAN & LAGOS (JUNE 2024)

Took love and support to the streets of Ibadan and Lagos, conducting medical outreaches in both locations and distributing essential materials. Through this initiative, we positively impacted a total of 134 okada and keke riders.



LOVE CONFERENCE 3.0

OYO TOWN (SEPTEMBER 2024)

Gathered 53 teenagers in Oyo Town, both in and out of school, to equip them with valuable vocational skills, including hairdressing, gift box crafting, and tech training. Additionally, we provided business startup funds and academic scholarships to support and reward top-performing students, empowering them to build brighter futures.



LOVE OUTREACH 4.0

OSHOGBO (DECEMBER 2024)

Visited the Juvenile Correctional Centre and Childcare Facility in Oshogbo, sharing God's Word and providing support through the donation of food items, Bibles, school supplies, and clothing. A total of 50 children were positively impacted by this outreach.

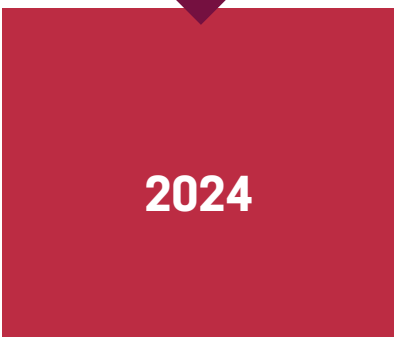

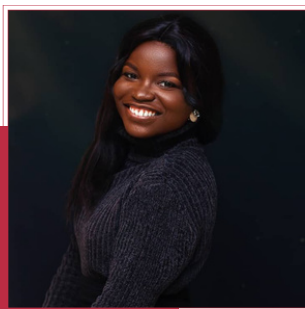

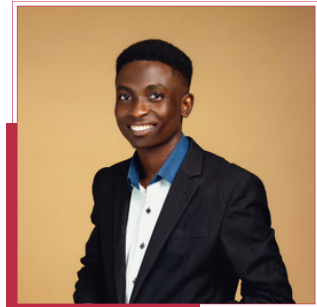
